

DIVING SAFETY

- Every diver is responsible for his own equipment (also in case of help or support from the crew members or others);
- Every diver's safety equipment includes: computer, S.M.B. (how do you use it?), mirror and torch, if not available you will find them on board (computer 40 € S.M.B. 5 € torch 5 € mirror free);
- The maximum depth for diving with normal air is 40 meters (if the diving license and experience allow it);
- If there is not any other indication from dive guide during the briefing the maximum dive time will be 60 minutes. Special treatment will be reserved for divers SCR and CCR (rebreathers);
- Diving profile and air consumption;
- Buddy system;
- Pre-diving equipment check;
- Good weighing check is important for successfully dive;
- Jumping and climbing up from the boat;
- Jumping and climbing up from the tender;
- In case of emergency use 2 S.M.B. (or yellow S.M.B.), to call the tender. A crew member will drop a tank with 9 mt. rope;
- Emergency exit: If need, divers are asked to exit using SOS signal (3 short 3 long 3 short) beating a lead on boat ladder or on the tender engine: divers will close the dive following the safety rules;
- How to deal with current;
- Oxygen therapy



- Divers under 75 years old without DAN insurance (or similar) can make it on board;
- All divers are asked to present a medical certificate upon check-in. Self-certification is accepted only if all point on the second page are marked on NO;
- The dive guide's aim is to guarantee the underwater safety by showing the features of the diving site, indicating any dangers following diving rules.

The dive guide will lead the group underwater but he will not be responsible if the briefing indication and depth limit will not be respected.
